

Cresyl Violet Acetate (0.1%, aqueous) (Cresyl Echt Violet)

Description: Designed to show selective staining of Nissl granules. Nissl granules are purple, nuclei of neuroglia and endothelial cells are slightly bluer than Nissl granules.

Storage: Room Temperature.

Procedure:

1. Use 10 ml of Cresyl Violet Acetate with 100 ml of buffer (three parts 0.2 M Acetic Acid to two parts 0.2 M Sodium Acetate, pH 4.45).
2. Stain 20 minutes in mixed solution.
3. Rinse quickly in 95% ethyl alcohol and then place in n-butyl alcohol, two changes of two minutes each.
4. Clear in xylene.
